Accelerator tunnel, Cryo Distribution System

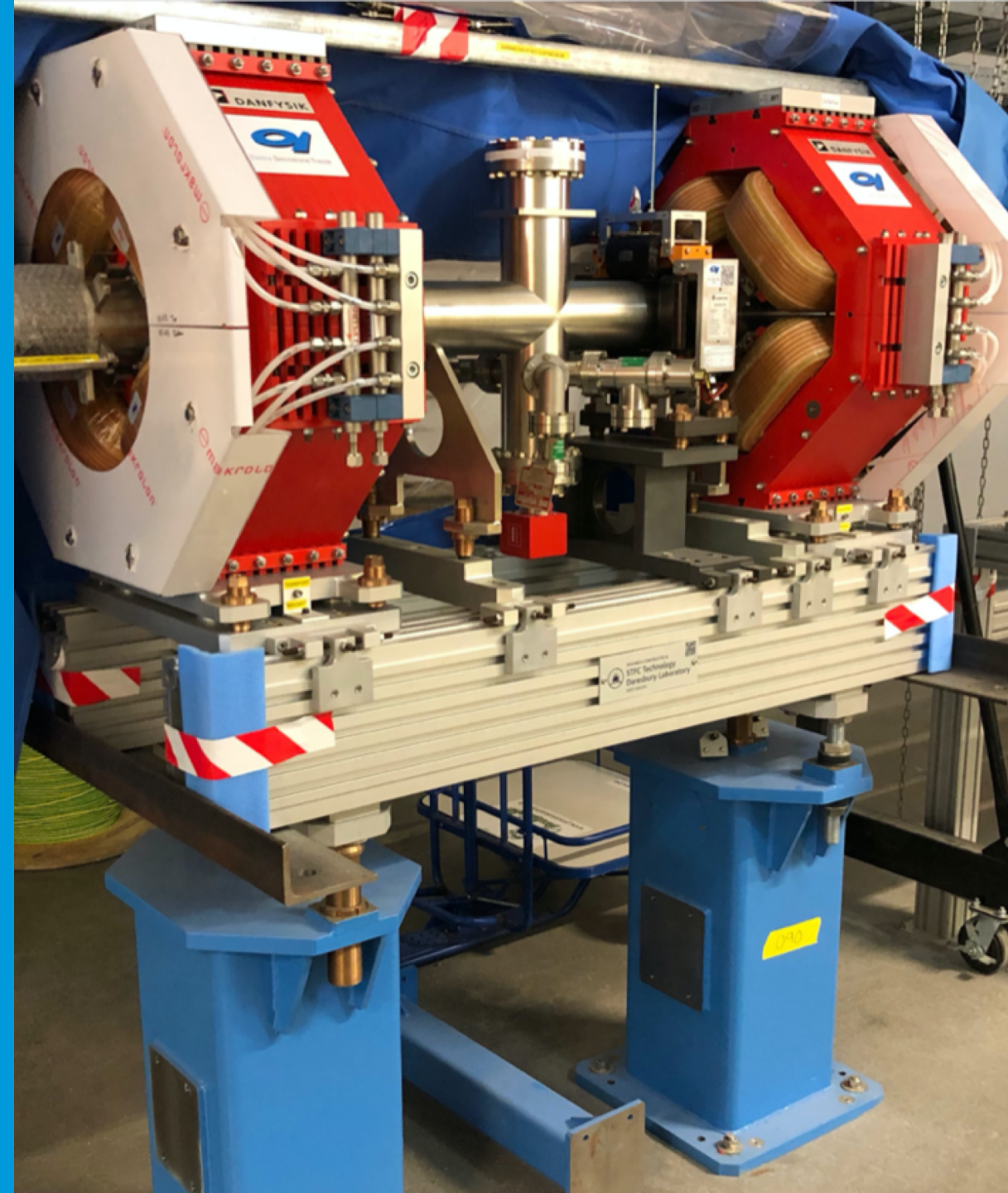

Governance update



ESS management has changed since PAC.06



- John Womersley resigned from the position of Director General effective March 1, 2021 and Mark Anthony assumed leadership of ESS in his capacity as the Deputy Director General
- The Council (C.23) appointed Technical Director Kevin Jones as the Acting Director General effective March 9, 2021 through October 31, 2021
- The Council (C.24) approved Helmut Schober, currently the Director of the Institut Laue-Langevin reactor neutron source in Grenoble, France, as the ESS Director General effective November 1, 2021
- Carlo Bocchetta has been serving as acting Technical Director effective March 9, 2021
- Kevin Jones and Carlo Bocchetta will return to their respective positions effective November 1, 2021
